



Tree & Shrub Planting Guide

REMOVE THE CONTAINER

1. Lay the plant on its side. Tap the bottom of the container and gently slide the container off of the root ball.
2. If the container does not slide off easily, cut it down the side with a sharp knife.
3. Vertically score the root ball on all 4 sides


PREPARE THE PLANTING HOLE

1. The planting site should have well-drained, amended soil
2. Dig the hole at least twice the width of the container and equal to the depth of the container.
3. Mix soil amendments into the soil that was dug out of the hole in a ration of 1/3 amendment to 2/3 backfill soil. Wallace's recommends compost or garden Soil.
4. Use the soil mixture to create a 3-4" high mound in the bottom of the hole and firm down to prevent settling.

PLANT THE TREE

1. Place the plant in the hole so that the top of the root ball is slightly (about 2") above the existing soil level.
2. Adjust the root ball so the trunk is straight.
3. Gradually backfill and continually pack the soil mixture around the root ball.

CARING FOR THE TREE

1. Water well immediately after planting. Use a starter fertilizer like Fertilome Root Stimulator or Espoma BioTone. This will promote root development and reduce transplant shock.
 2. Mulch the area with a 2-3" layer of your preferred mulch. The mulch will conserve moisture and reduce weeds. Remember to leave a ring around the tree trunk so the mulch is not touching the trunk.
 3. Continue to water the tree with 1 1/2" of water per week. This is especially important during the first planting season and during hot, dry periods.
 4. After the first growing season, use a tree and shrub fertilizer every spring and fall.

THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER:

- Planting, labor and delivery fees are not figured into the credit and must be paid again to have a replacement plant installed.
- Plants lost due to neglect, pests, disease, or extreme weather.
- Due to unpredictable temperature fluctuations in our area, we cannot warranty the hardiness of Annuals, Perennials, Roses, Azaleas, Boxwood, Rhododendrons, Holly, Japanese Maples, Dogwood trees or Aquatic Plants.
- Due to unpredictable temperature fluctuations in our area, we cannot warranty plants grown indoors or installed in aboveground planters or containers.

This offer is valid only when the failed plant is returned with a receipt within one year of purchase.
